Apply for Public Housing

To be considered for an apartment in a North Chicago Housing Authority Public Housing development, a completed application must be submitted. Below are the following ways in which a person can request an application:

Online: The online portal is highly encouraged, as you can update your contact and household information at any time. This will also allow you to check the status of your application whenever you would like. Visit our online portal at <https://portal.northchicagohousing.org/>. Please see instructions under 'Public Housing - How to apply'

In Person: Applications are available to pick up at the North Chicago Housing Authority office, located in Kukla Towers. ***No appointment is necessary*** The application can be submitted to the front office.

Mail: You can request to have an application mailed to you by contacting the front office. The application can be returned via mail; please mail all applications to:

- Elderly (age 62 and older)
- Disabled
- Lake County Resident and/or work in Lake County, IL. (excluding Waukegan)
